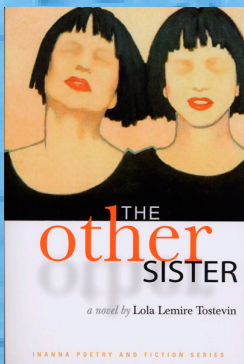

# The Other Sister

Lola Lemire Tostevin, a Franco-Ontarian bilingual poet and novelist who writes mostly in English, is one of the most innovative feminist writers in Canada. Her poetry titles include *Color of Her Speech*, *Gyno-Text*, *Double Standards*, 'Sophie, *Cartouches*, *Site-Specific Poems*, and *Punctum*. A translator from French into English of such writers as Anne Hébert, she has also published *Subject to Criticism*, a collection of critical essays and interviews with Canadian authors. She has published three novels, *Frog Moon*, *The Jasmine Man*, and, most recently, *The Other Sister*.
